



2017 CHARDONNAY (CH)

Tasting Notes

A bright, clean chardonnay sourced from the Yakima Valley AVA. Fermented in stainless steel tanks, notes of lime blossom and apple give way to great minerality with a lasting finish. A classic example of an Old World style Chablis

2017 RIESLING (RE)

Tasting Notes

Tasting Notes

Bright notes of white peach and lime on the nose; on the palate, vibrant acidity leads to flavors of passionfruit and citrus. Clean and classic.

2017 RESERVE CHARDONNAY (RESCH)

Tasting Notes

Golden in color due to its time in barrel, this wine undergoes malolactic fermentation that leads to an intense nose of baked apple, Meyer lemon and spice. Fuller bodied on the palate, this wine is balanced out by great minerality and a lengthy finish.

2017 ROSÉ (RS)

Tasting Notes

Provincial in color, this wine leads with aromas of strawberry blossom, stone fruits and melon. Great balance on the palate with bright fruit, acidity and a subtle richness.

Cooperage: Fermented in Stainless Steel.

Kept very cool for it's entire life.

2017 PINOT GRIS (PG)

Tasting Notes

Lively and crisp, this light bodied wine has notes of lime, apple and peach; balanced out with a lively acidity and refreshing finish.

2016 SANGIOVESE (SG)

Tasting Notes

Made with 18% Cabernet Sauvignon, this Tuscan style wine begins with notes of raspberry, spice, and cocoa. The palate shows flavors of both bright and dried fruits.

Firm tannins lead to a nice finish.

2016 GSM (GSM)

Tasting Notes

Classic southern Rhone. White pepper, black currant, and red fruits lead on the nose, while flavors of blackberry, raspberry, and anise flow throughout the wine leading to a long, smooth and balanced finish.

2017 VIOGNIER, ROUSSANNE, MARSANNE (VG)

Tasting Notes

With a mix of barrel and stainless steel fermentation, this wine has a great balance of weight and acidity.

Aromas of peach and honeysuckle lead into a rich mouthfeel of lemon and pineapple with a bright, crisp finish.

2016 RESERVE PINOT NOIR (RESPN)

Willamette Valley Pinot Noir, in the hands of one of the best Pinot producers in Washington State.

A classic from the Willamette Valley. Aromas of black cherry, licorice, and bramble. This wine leads with flavors of fresh raspberry and blackberry followed by an integration of spice.

2016 BORDEAUX (BDX)

Tasting Notes

This wine is a classic blend of equal parts Merlot and Cab Franc. Earth, red berries, and black fruits make up most of the nose while dark cherry and spice move into silky, integrated tannins. Great length on the finish.

2016 MALBEC (MB)

Tasting Notes

All Walla Walla fruit from Summit View Vineyard. Basically 5 year old vines above Seven Hills in new Sevien Property. Dark, bold, and inky, this wine has flavors of dark red fruits, violets, and good minerality. Subtle tannins and herbaceous spice lead to a pleasant lingering finish.

2016 CABERNET SAUVIGNON (CS)

Notes of bramble, black currant, and spice are followed by a wonderful palate of dark berries and minerality. This wine finishes with lasting tannin and balance. .
